### **My Responsibilities**

If accepted into the 2018 KTHFS Chiloquin Community Garden, I agree to the following:

1. I am responsible for planning, planting, harvesting, maintaining, watering and weeding my assigned plot.
2. I will maintain my garden within the borders of the plot (vines are kept within the box).
3. I will begin working my plot as soon as weather permits but no later than mid-May. The Community Garden Coordinator will monitor progress throughout the season and ensure each plot is fully planted by June 15, 2018.
4. I will notify the Community Garden Coordinator or KTHFS staff (Joseph Tibay or Lynda Daniel) immediately if I must give up my plot during the growing season.
5. I will use the water to water garden plants only and turn off the hose faucet after each use. I will water only my own assigned box.
6. I will use certified organic seeds, plants, fertilizers, herbicides or pesticides in a way that will not affect other plots to keep insects, pests and diseases under control.
7. I will pick only my own crops, unless given permission by another plot gardener.
8. I will return tools to the shed when finished.
9. I will keep my address, phone number and email address current with the Community Garden Coordinator and KTHFS staff (Joseph Tibay or Lynda Daniel).
10. I understand my expected expenses to plant (seeds and starts) and fertilize my plot for the season is my responsibility. In 2018, some seeds will be available from the Community Garden Coordinator.
11. Tobacco, alcohol and drug use is prohibited within the garden as well as the area surrounding the gate. If you do smoke, please remove and dispose of smoking material off the property.
12. Ethical and respectful behavior to others, including children. Unethical behavior will result in a 1 year ban from garden.

13. The garden is open from dusk to dawn.
14. I will lock the gate when leaving the garden and will not give the combination to anyone.
15. Pets are not allowed in the garden.
16. I will not hold liable Klamath Tribal Health & Family Services or any person or organization associated with the Chiloquin Community Garden for any accident, injury or loss that may occur at the garden site.
17. I will clear and clean my plot by the end of October.
18. I will check with the Community Garden Coordinator before donating any tools or other items to the garden. I will remove my own trash. At the end of the season, I will remove any personal gardening items that I have brought to the garden.
19. Members will not make any unlawful, improper or offensive use of the premises, doing so will result in a minimum 1 year ban from the garden; this includes the growing of marijuana, which is still a federal offense and can result in federal authorities stripping the entire garden -, doing so will result in a permanent ban from using the garden; will not permit any objectionable noise or odor to escape or to be emitted from the premises or do anything or permit anything to be done upon or about the premises in any way tending to create a nuisance.
20. The garden is the private property of Klamath Tribal Health & Family Services and is open to current members only.
